

# EVENT VENUE GUIDE BACHELOR'S GREEN

Located off Tone Road, Bachelor's Green is a well grassed area and is complete with an enclosed playground, undercover BBQ's, picnic tables and toilets. In close proximity to a shopping centre and fast food outlets, there is ample parking within a short walking distance. This park is ideal for a wide manner of events including circuses, pop-up food and wine events, car shows and fairs.

### SIte Suitability & Suggested Capacity

Bachelors Green is suitable for low, medium and high impact events. The site is able to include; amusement rides, inflatable structures, stages and animals. Events with a capacity of up to 2,000 may be considered for this venue.

### Shared Use Considerations

Where possible, access to public facilities must be maintained during the event, event set-up and event packdown periods.

These public facilities include;

- The Lions Club Playground
- The Wangaratta Liberty Swing
- · Toilet facilities

Adjacent to the park are two significant institutions, the Wangaratta Police Precinct and the Wangaratta Family Daycare and Family Services Centre. Both buildings require 7 day access and any event should ensure that access and parking is provided for both buildings.

The Wangaratta Family Services Centre shares a low fence boundary with the venue event infrastructure should be placed away from this fenceline where possible. The Wangaratta Family Services Centre operates during business hours on weekdays and consideration should be given to noise during set-up pack-down operations during these times.

Adjacent to the venue is the Wangaratta Artists Society which shares vehicle access from Tone Road. The society conducts periodic exhibitions and events are encouraged to speak with the society to avoid potential clashes.

### **Environmental Sensitivities**

Whilst Bachelor's Green is significantly open, it is bounded by stands of significant trees, particularly over the vehicle access route, carpark and playground. Events should ensure that infrastructure is placed away from trees.

Vehicle access to the site should be carefully managed to minimise impacts on grassed surfaces, garden beds and significant trees.

## **Amplified Sound Considerations**

Whilst Bachelor's Green is directly surrounded by businesses and industry, residential areas are situated one street back in all directions and noise must be carefully considered for events in this site.

It is recommended that all noise is limited to 10pm and, where possible, stages are situated to face north.

### Community Notification and Consultation

Notification and consultation requirements will depend on the size and nature of your event and potential impacts to the community. Council may require any event to undertake notification activities including; letter box drops, on-road signage prior to the event and advertising in local newspapers.

At a minimum you should consider communication with the businesses mentioned over page and residents and businesses in:

- Handley Street
- Tone Road
- Greta Road

### Toilets

Bachelor's Green has one toilet block within the venue. Public access to this block must be maintained, particularly for visitors to the Lions Club playground. This block should be supplemented with additional toilets for all medium and high impact events and may not be considered for events that are enclosed or for the provision of alcohol.

Vehicle access to the site is via the vehicle access road from Tone Road. Vehicle Access to the event site should be actively managed to minimise impacts on grassed surfaces.


#### Power
